FAQs:

- **Can I exit close to the ADA Shuttle stop?**
 - Yes, you can exit at the Accessible Entrance on 6th & Juniper St.
- **Can I exit and re-enter?**
 - Yes, as long as you have a valid ticket for the day you are wanting to re-enter.
- **How do I get the ADA shuttle?**
 - Let a volunteer know that you need an ADA shuttle at the shuttle stop or in the festival and they will call one for you.
- **What are the shuttle hours?**
 - Saturday: 8:00 am until 12 Midnight
 - Sunday: 8:00 am until 11:00 pm
- **What is the terrain of the Festival?**
 - Some areas have grass and are on a slope.
 - The Prism resource area near the entrance of the festival is located on a flat grassy section of the park and is about 0.1 miles long and 0.1 miles wide.
 - The loop portion of the Festival along Balboa Dr. is about 0.6 miles long and has a change in elevation of about 60 ft. (about a 3% grade), going downhill from the entrance to the bottom of the loop.
- **Are there Accessible Restrooms?**
 - All restroom areas have Accessible Portable Restrooms. These are prioritized for individuals with disabilities. Select restroom areas have sinks that do not require a foot pump.
