FAQs:

- Can I exit close to the ADA Shuttle stop?
 - Yes, you can exit at the Accessible Entrance on 6th & Juniper St.
- Can I exit and re-enter?
 - Yes, as long as you have a valid ticket for the day you are wanting to re-enter.
- How do I get the ADA shuttle?
 - Let a volunteer know that you need an ADA shuttle at the shuttle stop or in the festival and they will call one for you.
- What are the shuttle hours?
 - Saturday: 8:00 am until 12 Midnight
 - Sunday: 8:00 am until 11:00 pm
- What is the terrain of the Festival?
 - Some areas have grass and are on a slope.
 - The Prism resource area near the entrance of the festival is located on a flat grassy section of the park and is about 0.1 miles long and 0.1 miles wide.
 - The loop portion of the Festival along Balboa Dr. is about 0.6 miles long and has a change in elevation of about 60 ft. (about a 3% grade), going downhill from the entrance to the bottom of the loop.

Are there Accessible Restrooms?

 All restroom areas have Accessible Portable Restrooms. These are prioritized for individuals with disabilities. Select restroom areas have sinks that do not require a foot pump.
